*Many of our families qualify for the State and Nationally Funded Free and Reduced Breakfast/Lunch Program. Forms are available in the CES Office and can be completed any time during the school year. All are confidentially processed. A new form is required every year.

Meal Options

You can control certain aspects of your child's lunch account by simply letting our lunchroom staff know. For example, you may wish for your child not to purchase breakfast or to buy juice instead of milk. In the first day packet a form with lunch information is sent home and you can indicate preferences there. You can update this information at any time by contacting our lunchroom staff. 138.

If a student is allergic to milk, he/she may be able to receive a juice supplement instead of milk with their school lunch. A note is required each year from the student's doctor or medical authority stating the child's allergies and is kept on file with the CES nurse's office.

On Early Release Days (half-days-1st and last days of school) breakfast will be served, but there will not be lunch. On our Professional Development Days (Late Arrival) breakfast will not be served, but lunch will be offered.

Payments

The lunchroom uses a Point of Sale system referred to as Skyward. It works much like a checking account in that money is deposited in and then students can draw on those funds to purchase a meal. Important steps for always insuring money is available for your child include:

- Checks should include first and last name of student. Cash should be put in an envelope with first and last name of student.
- If paying for more than one student, you must indicate all student's names and the amount you want allocated to each student. You can include payments for students at McMurray and/or the High School.
- Properly labeled payments can be turned into the lunch bucket in the office.
- If a student's account has a negative balance, a reminder will come home either by email or a paper slip brought home by the student. If you have an email address, but are not receiving reminders, your child's account is either positive or you may check with the office to make certain we have it listed correctly. If you do not have email, please be sure to check for any reminders that will come home on either Thursday or Friday of each week.
