GENERAL SUMMARY

Provide school counseling services as assigned including assessment, instruction and evaluation of students, instructional support, and social-emotional support, with a consistent focus on educational justice and equity

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Under the supervision of the Building Principal or designee, the position performs some or all of the following typical duties:

- Provide PBIS skills support for students and staff.
- Guide students in understanding self and others, assist in development of effective social skills
- Provide leadership in school-based diversity awareness and training
- Develop and lead school-to-school transition activities
- Work collaboratively with students, staff, and parents to provide academic planning/support, and goal setting, ensuring that the needs of all students are addressed including underrepresented groups.
- Communicate regularly with students and parents.
- Serve as member of the Response To Intervention team to identify at-risk students and implement interventions to enhance success
- Use and analyze data to help students succeed academically.
- Fulfill other job related responsibilities as assigned
