HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR

GENERAL SUMMARY

Provide school counseling services as assigned including instructional support, social-emotional support, and post-secondary planning with a consistent focus on educational justice and equity

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Under the supervision of the Building Principal, the position performs some or all of the following typical duties:

- Provide academic skills support including organizational, study and test-taking skills.
- Guide students in understanding self and others, assist in development of effective social skills with a focus on equity and cross-cultural understanding.
- Provide leadership in school-based diversity awareness and training
- Develop and lead school-to-school transition activities.
- Work collaboratively with students, staff and parents to provide academic planning/support, goal setting, and post-secondary education planning ensuring that the needs of all students are addressed including underrepresented groups.
- Communicate regularly with students and parents.
- Serve as member of the intervention team to identify academically and/or socially atrisk students and implement interventions to enhance success.
- Use and analyze data to help students succeed academically.
