### **Homeroom / Advisory**

Homeroom is a time for students to gain and share information, build community, read independently, participate in social/emotional learning and other topics including bullying prevention. Identified students receive support in reading, math, and other life skills. Daily homeroom classes consist of students from each grade—an opportunity for the older students to support the younger ones, and for the younger ones to learn from the older ones. Student-led conferences are conducted through homeroom.

## Academics, continued

**Math:** McMurray uses *Connected Math 3* and *Illustrative Math* for all grades. *Big Ideas Algebra* is used for 8th grade Algebra. Additional online resources are used in all grades to help students sharpen reasoning, computation, geometric, pre-algebraic and algebraic skills in a conceptual and integrated program. All math classes are year long at McMurray.

**Healthy Living:** These combination PE/Health classes focus on helping students learn tools to lead healthy lives. The PE portion is centered on aerobic and skill-related fitness (movement, coordination, balance). The Health portion covers the Life Skills prevention program, fitness awareness, and nutrition. Each grade level takes one semester of Healthy Living.

**Technology:** Our students take a one semester computer course in both 6th and 7th grades. Students gain an understanding of PC and web-based applications and focus on developing keyboarding, research and application skills.
